The Erasmus Mundus Joint Master in Education, Migration and Diversity (EDU_MIG) invites highly motivated students from around the world to apply for the 2026 intake! At EDU_MIG, we value diversity as a source of strength – your unique background, perspectives, and experiences will enrich our truly international learning community. We look forward to welcoming you to the program!

This unique two-year interdisciplinary program is jointly offered by three European partner universities: the University of Education Schwäbisch Gmünd in Germany, the University of Gävle in Sweden, and the University of Calabria in Italy. The EDU_MIG Master's focuses on often-overlooked, de-centred, rural, and small urban areas that have long been shaped by both emigration and immigration. By studying and living in different regional contexts, students gain rich and multifaceted insights into education, migration, and diversity beyond major metropolitan centres. EDU_MIG is committed to fostering inclusive societies that embrace multilingualism, religious diversity, and social equity in all its dimensions.

Program highlights:

- multiple degrees awarded by three European universities
- an interdisciplinary, international, and multilingual master's program
- study mobility across several countries
- study places each year for 25 international students (a majority funded with scholarships of the Erasmus Mundus program)
- a vast network of academic and non-academic professional partners in Germany, Sweden, Italy, Türkiye and Benin

Scholarship Application Period:

15th December 2025 – 15th February 2026

Apply during this period to be considered for the Erasmus Mundus scholarship, which covers tuition and student fees, health insurance, and a monthly living allowance.

Self-Funded Application Period:

01st April 2026 – 31st May 2026

Applicants who wish to join the program without a scholarship can apply during this period. Also, candidates who have applied for scholarships but have not been accepted can be considered for the second application process. The health-insurance will be covered for self-funded students as well. Further, self-funded students can get ERASMUS funding for up to two terms of mobility.

Program start: October 2026

Join an international community of learners dedicated to becoming internationally trained professionals who e.g. develop, foster, and critically evaluate diversity-oriented and migration-sensitive approaches in schools, adult education, public organizations, companies, and NGOs.
