PROGRAMME

This semester programme is meant for both international and local students, in mixed classrooms. Our aim is to prepare students to live and work in a multicultural environment, free from prejudices.

NOMINATION

Nomination via the forms sent to the central international office of your university. The deadline for nomination is 1 May.

APPLICATION

After nomination by your university, you will be accepted or not. Once accepted you must proceed in the flow of required steps and documents. Deadline 8 May.

REGISTRATION

Once you have completed your steps and official learning agreement, we'll send a link for registration to get your login and student card and for being enrolled in the agreed courses.

LANGUAGE OF INSTRUCTION

English: minimum required level is CEFR B2. Proof of this requirement or any certification by partner institution must be uploaded in the Mobility Online application system.

REGISTRATION AT THE CITY COUNCIL

Every incoming student must register at the city services within 7 days of arrival. This can be done online [in English](#) ([in Dutch](#))

Every person without the Belgian nationality who is coming to Belgium to study, must have a student residence permit. Therefore register as soon as possible (within 7 days) after your arrival so that you can enjoy your stay to the fullest.
