Course programme for international exchange students taught in English

Winter Term (October – February)

Courses

- Communication and teamwork (2.5 ECTS points)
- Evidence-based practice in nursing and healthcare (2.5 ECTS points)
- Models of health and illness in health sciences (5 ECTS points)
- Management of care processes in an interdisciplinary team (5 ECTS points)
- Project development in nursing science (8 ECTS points)

Overall aims and content

The courses will focus on different aspects of nursing science and enable students to develop their knowledge and skills in evidence-based nursing practice and development. Students learn about principles of effective communication in a team, acquire understanding on behavioural and socio-cognitive influences on health, and evidence-based care processes. In addition, students have an opportunity to develop their skills in using scientific literature to explore and answer a defined nursing science question.



Assessment

- Communication and teamwork – Written exam paper either in English or German
- Evidence-based practice in nursing and healthcare – Written exam paper either in English or German
- Models of health and illness – Written exam paper in English
- Management of care processes – Written piece of work (Essay) either in German or English
- Project development in nursing science – Presentation of a project

Target group

Bachelor students in the field of nursing and healthcare. No prior knowledge is required. International students will study together with local students.

Language:

Courses are taught in English (level B2 is recommended).

Please note - Students with good knowledge of German are welcome to visit entire range of courses in agreement with the study co-ordinator.
